Financial Assistance

We are able to offer financial assistance to people with proven emergency need who have lived in Ashland County for at least 90 days. Financial assistance for the following may be given one time every twelve (12) months:

- Rent Eviction
- Utility Disconnection
- Emergency (non-narcotic) Prescriptions

Food

We offer food every other month to those with a proven emergency need that have lived in Ashland County for at least 90 days.

Satellite Food Distribution

Once a month, volunteers distribute food to those in the Polk and Perrysville areas who are food insecure and unable to obtain transportation to our Cleveland Avenue location.

POLK: 3rd Tuesday of each month at the Polk Fire Station.

PERRYSVILLE: 4th Wednesday of each month at the Perrysville Community Center.
