You will need to provide proof that the requirements have been met:

- Income: Pay stubs, letters from child support or Social Security that report monthly amounts received or if you are receiving assistance through Job and Family Services.
- School Status: A copy of a school report card/transcript.
- Minor in the home if youth is 18 or older and not in school: On applications, please fill in each family member you live with and their birth date.
- Under the age of 25 and a parent: provide a copy of the child's birth certificate with your name listed as a parent.



Eligibility Requirements:

- Household Income is no more than 200% of Federal Poverty Level (see chart left)
- Youth participants must be residents of Ashland County
- Be 14-17 years old or age 18-24 and have another family member who is under 18 living in the same residence
- Be 18 and still in High School or Graduating in 2016. If you are 18 and still in school you must be on track to graduate prior to turning 19.
- Be under the age of 25 and be a parent (Custodial or Non-Custodial)
- Inquires will be taken by phone or stop in for an application
- Registration will be taken on a FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS
